CANADA and BULGARIA Are Fighting For Michael Kapoustin

The Swindler Arrested At Frankfurt Airport on February 7

Michael Kapoustin was arrested on February 7 at the Frankfurt airport, confirmed the National Investigation Department yesterday.

Kapoustin was detained upon request of the Bulgarian Prosecutor's Office, **as well as on behalf of the Canadian government**, according to Sofia's District Attorney Nestor Nestorov. It is only a question of time who will be the first to send the extradition documents. **Canada also wants to get hold of Kapoustin because of financial frauds and tax evasion**. We will start checking whether he has given up **his Bulgarian passport**, said Nestorov. Current information is that he has both a Bulgarian and a Canadian passport.
